Mrs. Mwakazi is the principal of Makongeni Girls High School which has Six streams, with a population of 1500 students and a teacher population of 60. The school is located on 100 acres land. The school development since Mrs. Mwakazi landed in the school for the last three years since 2019, has stagnated although the parents are very active in honouring their obligations of paying school fees. A team of Quality Assurance and Standards Officers carried out an impromptu inspection in the school on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of Term One in 2022. The findings of the officers were as follows: The last time the school prepared a school development and strategic plan was 2013, which it expired in 2018. About 50 acres of the school land is unutilized and is just bushy. The staff were never involved in decision making with regard to critical school issues. The principal is never concerned about student and teacher motivation, the school performance in national examination has been declining as shown below.
